TM Italia at Superdesignshow, Superstudio Più Milano
Milan Design Week 2016

TM Italia participates in the 2016 edition of Milan Design Week with an exhibition held at renowned Superstudio Più, showcasing the result of more than fifty years of experience in bespoke kitchen furniture, merging technological innovation and excellence in craftsmanship Made in Italy.

A triptych of sensorial architectures, which, like perceptual shrines, contain three unedited kitchens. An ideal space expressing the tailoring offered by TM Italia and values, which wrap the product with creative freedom of who every day delivers unique pieces tailored on the needs of the client.

A contemporary flair characterizes the second kitchen, combining the TM Italia concepts D90-12 and D90-TP. This model merges innovation in domotics and technical materials with an architectural inspiration such as stainless steel, azure line glass, lacquered finishes in steel tones and rift cut oak, featuring an ash finish.

An International, amber allure enriches the materiality of Neolite, natural evolution of the iconic Petra concept by TM Italia. A balanced, monolithic system embraces primordial matters: antiquated bronze, Brown Gold stone and particular essences of sycamore together with bronze fabric laminate glass.

The 2016 novelties by TM Italia are an organic integration to the existing collections: new experimental solutions for the Lab collection, an evolution of the very first Lab model, two integrations to concepts of the Made to Measure collections, combined in a contemporary kitchen.

Miuccia

design: Ruadelpapavero Creative Studio

The Miuccia kitchen is shrouded in the mystery of midnight blue, the preciousness of rose gold and the solidity of marble — all skilfully combined in a neo-déco interpretation of contemporary space. The simplicity of its pure forms is enriched by sophisticated surface incisions and punctuated by handles with a rose gold finish, bestowing refined elegance on the whole composition.

Large sideboards form the backdrop to two island benches with marble tops. The sink and stove are recessed via two sliding chopping boards on tapered guides which, when closed, restore the perfect levelness of the bench top.

The frames are raised off the ground by metal sleds with a rose gold finish, giving a great sense of lightness to the volumes. The storage compartments provide ample space for crockery and food. The appliances, including the dishwasher, oven, refrigerator and freezer are positioned inside the cupboards.

The formal precision of the Miuccia enables it to be sophisticatedly combined with the areas adjoining the kitchen, allowing the customer to supplement the compartments or apply Miuccia to an open space with a distinct style.

D90-12 D90-TP

The intriguing appeal of modern architecture characterizes this model by TM Italia, dominated by materials typical of futuristic cityscapes, such as glass and metal. The cabinet unit looks like the glazed façade of highrises, punctuated by the regular rhythm of windows and structural elements, creating a graphical pattern of lines and a play of transparencies and reflections, extending the complex virtually. Wooden laths animate the glazed surface as if they were sunblinds.

The work island boasts a linear and sober shape like a horizontal cube. The sink and the hob are hidden under the worktop, ready to be revealed whenever needed. Also a comfortable rack is vertically extractable in order to dispense cookware and spices during cooking.

With a 90-degree angle, a convivial corner is connected to the work island offering space for breakfast. Made with glass, it hosts wooden containers underneath, creating an interesting contrast and accentuating, with its modular look, the urban feel of the design. Unexpected and ironic detail: elements recalling urban furniture emanate infrared light, serving as a plate warmer.

Neolite

Neolite is the evolution of the Petra concept by TM Italia, dominated by the use of natural stone. Thanks to seamlessly applied slats of Brown Gold natural stone, the big work island at the centre of the kitchen acts like a big monolith. It perfectly integrates the sink, the hob and the extractor hood as well as of the vertically extractable oven below the work top thanks to innovative automated mechanisms and advanced technological solutions.

The wall unit composes of two parts: one made of five columns with retractable doors with an antiqued bronze finish. These columns host ultra-modern kitchen appliances and offer space for food and cookware. The second one is an open cabinet featuring side walls in essence of sycamore, shelves with an back-lit, antiqued bronze finish and a back wall made with bronze fabric laminate glass.

The Neolite kitchen complex also includes a suspended wall unit, which, with its structure and finishes, takes up the floor standing wall unit.

In its overall conception, the Neolite kitchen creates the perfect link to the living area of every apartment, boasting premium finishes and incorporating stylistic elements, which recall typical characteristics of living room furniture
