The architect STEVEN WITTOUCK has been formed by Maart van Severen

Following his passion for design, he created his own company MOCA LINE in 2010 and has raised it over the last 5 years to the level of the leading editors in Europe and always respecting the evident laws of " construction " and far away of superficial effects and fashion

His world-wide break-through came through a minimalistic synthesis between the noble modern art (sculpture) and an elegant construction of a useful sideboard: FRAMED by Koenraad Ruys which the French design revue INTRAMUROS has published in their design guide of 2014/15, showing only the best of the design from Bauhaus until now

It was followed by a table system with 42 possible variations through the different sizes and finishings and a 4 m long conference table (all tables can be equipped with a hidden canal for cables) And developed by the architect Philippe Allaey for the home as well as for the small and medium contract projects

Last year it was followed by a new shelf system in poplar wood and inspired by the bamboo construction in Asia and shown now in the Museum of Modern Art in Gent created by LHOAS & LHOAS

Steven Wittouck himself has added the armchair CUBIC inspired by Rietveld, a stool CUBIC covered with foam and felt tissue, the side table CROSS in MDF painted in white, red and black, a very comfortable pouf called SEAL, light and tough at the same time in dense foam covered with felt tissue specially for kids to bounce it around at home or in the kindergarten and last but not the least, the low coffee table COVER made out of thin steel plates painted in a variety of colors which results in a light but strong construction

The collection has been shown for the first time in Kortrijk 2014 with an important press coverage and even the first cover of the Belgian newspaper "De Morgen"
