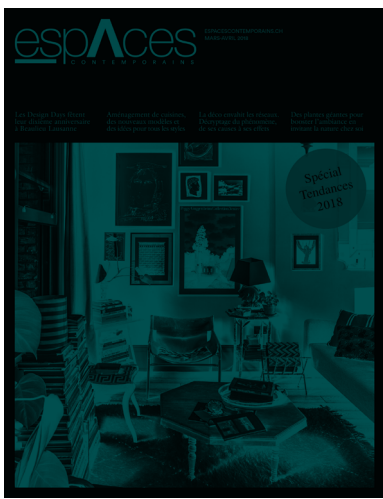

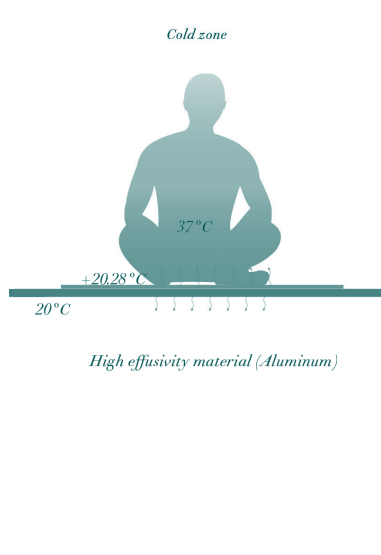
HEAD – Genève

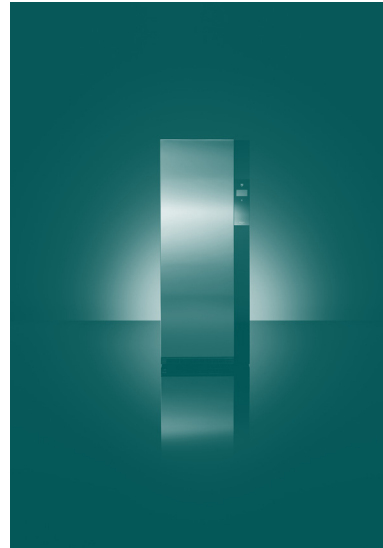

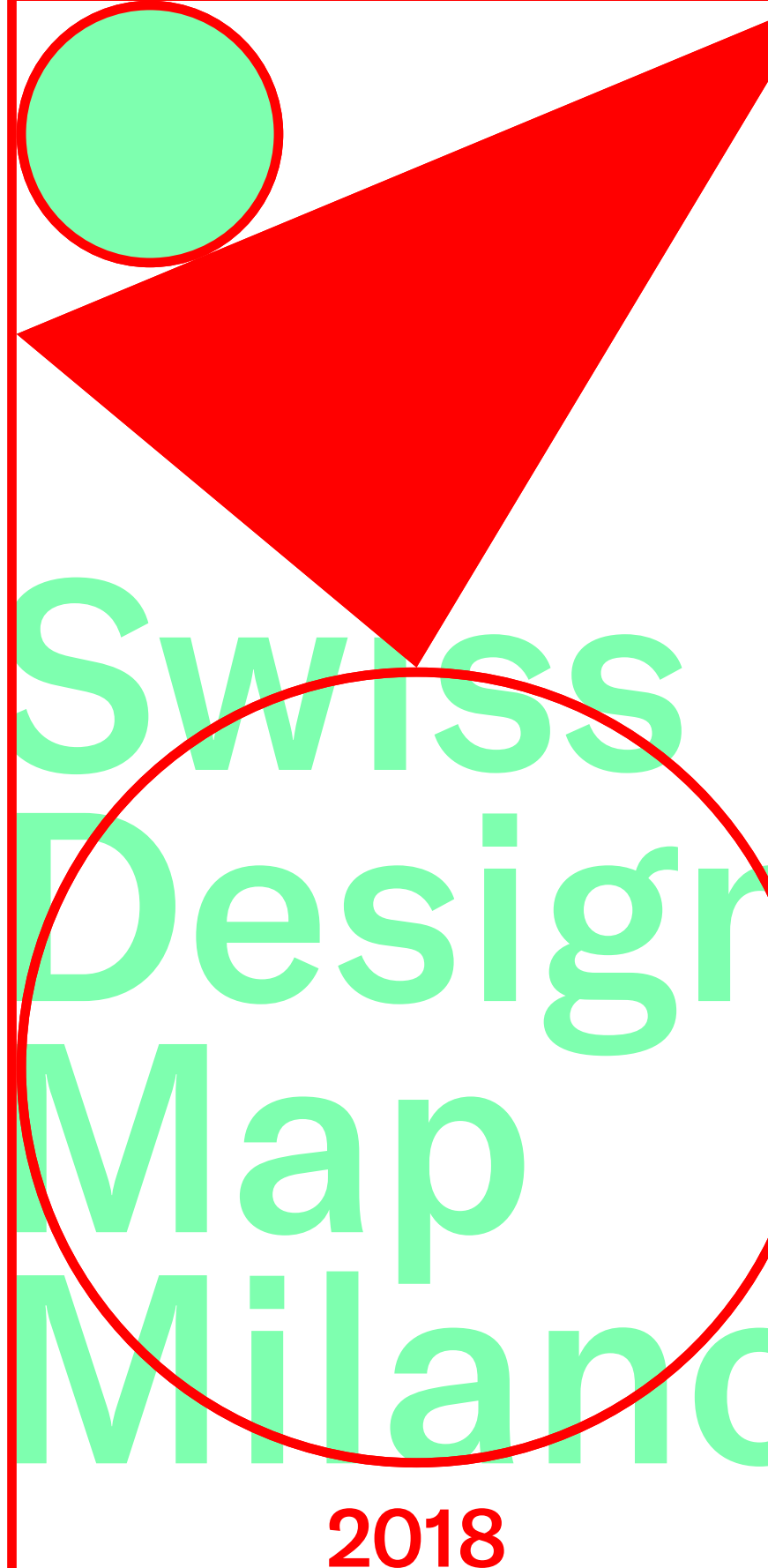
