



MY LITTLE PERFUME – RING

The Concept

Rose water production ("golab" in Farsi) has been part of the **Persian tradition** for over seven hundred years. It is aromatized water, obtained by steam distillation of rose petals. **Mohammadi Rose's** petals, originally from Qamsar, in the province of Kashan, in Eastern Iran, are used.

Rose water is mainly produced during the GOLABGIRI ceremony, which takes place annually between mid-May and mid-June. **In this period the entire province of Kashan smells of this rose.**

The Object and the Technique

A ring inspired by Mohammadi Rose.

The mobile central part represents one of the best applications of 3D Printing or Additive Manufacturing.
