A private garden from the late 1800s in the center of the city, 2000 square meters with 49 different tree species, including specimens of European beech, magnolia, white elm, ailanthus (known as tree of heaven), deodar cedar, and sycamore. Various bird species are hidden amidst the treetops and the shrubs: kestrel, common swift, chaffinch, house sparrow, robin, great tit, jackdaw. A secret paradise in which to rediscover the beauty of nature, an oasis in which to linger, taking a break from the frenetic pace of the city.

In this setting, Nobodyandco., from 4 to 9 April 2017, presents its new furnishings. The installation is by Studio Toogood, which has designed the Follies, small "extravagant" architectural structures in vogue in English gardens in the 18th century. Inside them, visitors are invited to view five new projects by Nobodyandco.: Pet Table, Relog and Missing Ocean, Uphill and the Sliced Bookshelf. The "Wild Bakery" is a creation of Arabeschi di Latte and Vermouth Aperitivo by OSCAR.697.
