

**Schloss Hollenegg for Design presents:
Sara Ricciardi's *ARCADIA*
an immersive installation anticipating "Legacy"**

Schloß Hollenegg for Design is an international program, based in Austria, initiated in 2015 by Alice Stori Liechtenstein, to support design research, thinking and critique, while offering a platform to young emerging designers.

From the 4th until 7th the of May 2017, the castle of Hollenegg, in Austria will open its doors to host a design exhibition, under the title **Legacy**. Visitors will be able to walk in many of the rooms of the castle, normally closed to the public, and see the work of nineteen designers next to antique objects and furniture.

To anticipate the "Legacy" exhibition, reveal something of the magic and beauty of Schloss Hollenegg, Sara Ricciardi will bring elements of the castle to Milan, creating an immersive installation in via Cesare Correnti. 5VIE art+design has decided to invite and produce "Arcadia" which will explore the importance of heritage, in personal and collective terms, looking both at the past and at the future.

Sara Ricciardi (Benevento, 1989) is one Italy's young design talents. After having studied in Milan, Istanbul and New York, she is now living and working in Milan as product designer and art director. She teaches social design at NABA and at Domus Academy, as well as leading "Design thinking" workshops worldwide. She is a finalist of the 'Officine Panerai Next Generation Designer Award', part of the 'Wallpaper* Design Awards 2018'.
